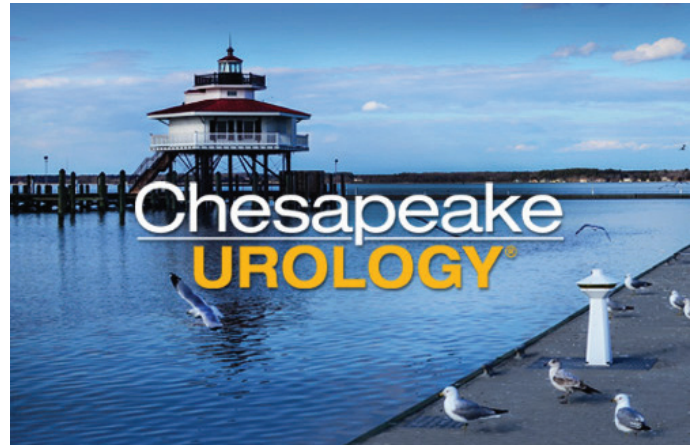

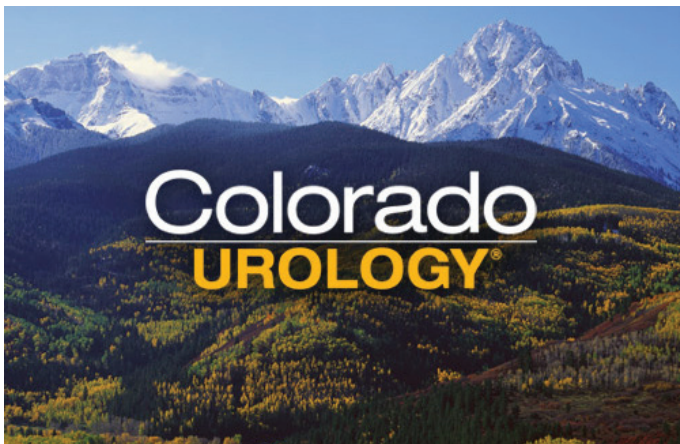

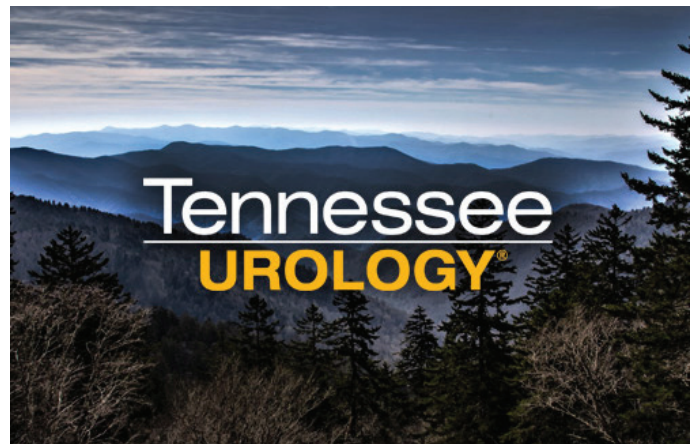

Affiliate practice ambulatory surgery centers are certified by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC).

All physicians and staff have access to state-of-the-art urological equipment for surgery.

Newly hired physicians benefit from advice, support, and encouragement from knowledgeable mentors. Upon hire, we match all associate physicians with experienced physician mentors or mentoring groups to guide new physicians as they navigate their new workplace.

Physician mentors are:

- Located in the same POD and possess a similar skill set to new associates.
- Responsible for providing guidance around chart preparation, clinical best practices, training, and support in early OR cases at the hospital and in the ASC.
- Available to help with the transition into the private practice setting.

Along with the mentorship program, United Urology Group provides professional development opportunities including training from senior physicians across the network, Continuing Medical Education (CME), live and virtual trainings, opportunities for involvement in local medical societies, retreats and conferences, and more.

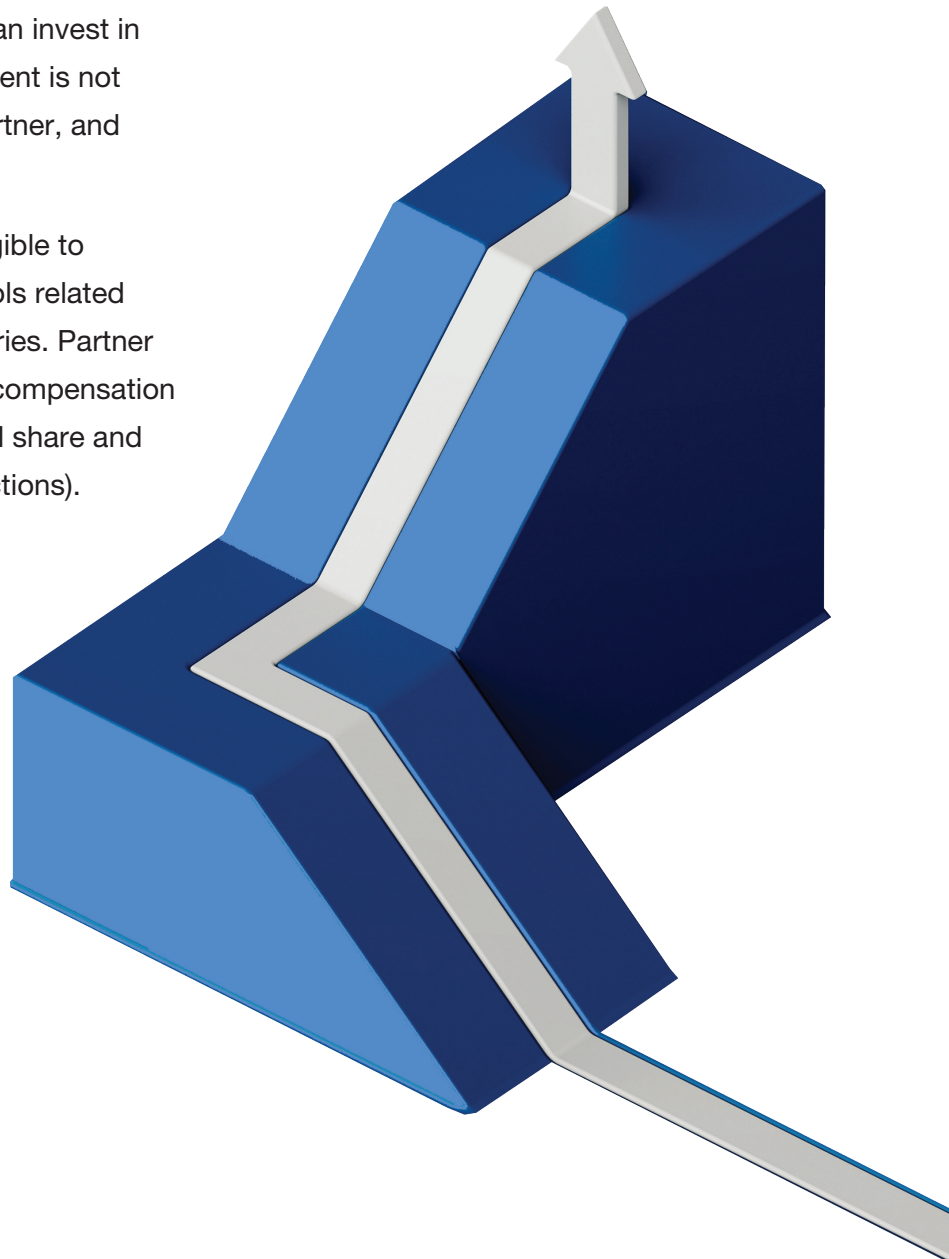
The Path to Partnership

When a United Urology Group practice affiliate hires a physician, they begin their employment as an Associate Physician. All new physicians are given sufficient time to become acclimated and to begin to ramp up their practice at the pace they're comfortable with. Regular performance reviews are conducted between a new physician and the clinical and operational leadership teams.

THE PATH TO PARTNERSHIP IS TYPICALLY TWO YEARS.

Upon achieving partner status, physicians can invest in United Urology Group, however this investment is not required. There is no buy-in to become a partner, and investment is voluntary.

After becoming a partner, physicians are eligible to participate in shareholder compensation pools related to ASCs, IMRT, Pathology, and other ancillaries. Partner pay is determined by the practice affiliate's compensation plan, which is usually a combination of equal share and productivity-based pay (RVUs or cash collections).



Investing in Your Future

United Urology Group (UUG) is owned by our private equity (PE) partner and urologists. Today, approximately 40% of the organization is owned by urologists and that percentage will continue to increase as more physicians are elevated to senior physician status.

PE OWNERSHIP & INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES



Does my investment in United Urology Group determine my annual compensation?

A. No. You are eligible for senior physician compensation once you are approved by your respective practice's physician leadership. Your investment in UUG is a separate and distinct opportunity to invest in a PE-backed investment vehicle, an opportunity few physicians are afforded outside of UUG.



When is a physician eligible to invest in United Urology Group?

A. A physician may have the opportunity to invest in UUG upon elevation from associate physician to senior physician status, which has typically been two years.



What type of instrument am I purchasing and is it the same type of security our private equity investor holds?

A. Anyone who purchases equity in UUG, including our private equity sponsor, is purchasing a common equity security. In other words, there is no investment difference between the securities held by physicians vs. our PE partner.



When is your investment realized?

A. Physicians are invested in a privately-held company and, thus, the security is not liquid. Physicians can realize the investment upon a sale of the company.
